You will be pleased to see the delectable results of their labor; the "Cooking with Carats" diverse collection of appetizers, main dishes, desserts, specialty drinks, etc. cookbook. Kudos Program committee. The cook book is priced at \$5 to members to supplement printing cost. It will be available for all Carats at the 2018 Macon Conclave.
- The 2ⁿ Vice President and Membership Committee Chair, Carat Carlotta McCoy (Chicago) annually submitted an accurate accounting of Membership status in all required categories: active membership, eligibility list for National Office, required Conclave attendance, etc.

 Budget and Finance committee Chair, Carat Linda Williams
 (Columbus) created a new format for managing the finances with
 precision by including specific line item expenditure in each
 category of allocated funds and adding an Actual expenditures
 category following the proposed budget allotment, to facilitate
 reconciling the income and expenditures account balance and
 needed modifications to the ensuing proposed budget.
- Financial Secretary, Carat Edith Johnson (Washington Chapter) requested and was approved to purchase fifty (50) Blue 3 ring Binders to have an inventory to sell to Chapters for new member documents. She has provided the checks and balances with the

Treasurer for Board meeting Luncheon Money collected, Per Capita Income and the "Cooking with the Carats" Cookbook.

- National Parliamentarian, and Constitution and Bylaws committee Chair, Carat Brenda Willingham (Philadelphia) and committee have incorporated the Audit and Archives committees language into the Constitution and Bylaws amended document 2017; the amendment to increase the Carateer registration from \$50 to \$100 was approved at the 2017 Conclave and will be incorporated into the 2018 amended Constitution and Bylaws document.
- National Historian Cart Audrey Jackson (S t. Louis)
 Archives committee Chair,
 Carat Brenda Coleman (Montgomery Chapter)
 Liaison to Moorland Spingarn Research Center and Library (MSRCL)
 Carat Kathleen Hopkins Smith (Washington), have reviewed all relevant documents and drilled down to the salient artifacts, documents, photos and memorabilia each Chapter will retrieve, organize and submit for our August 2018 inaugural submission to the MSRCL at Howard University, Washington, D.C.
- Policy and Guidelines Committee Chair, Carat Tyna Davis, (Montgomery) and the committee have updated the Policy and Guidelines Manual to include the processes related to the Audit committee and Archives Committee amendments to the Bylaws. A revised Policy and Guidelines Manual will be available electronically at the Macon Chapter 2018 Conclave
- National Ethics Committee Chair, Carat Barbara Pinder (Chicago) proposed Ethics Policy and Guidelines for resolving Ethical issues which will be incorporated in the Ethics Manual.
- National Corresponding Secretary, Carat Darlene Britford (Columbus) disseminated a barrage of essential communications keeping Carats informed, updated, and instructed on the business of Carats, Inc. I cannot begin to thank her enough for her oversight of the "Dates to Remember" and processes to be employed in all aspects of Carats, Inc. business protocol, as well as, updating the National Directory so that we are able at a glance, to contact any of our 344 Carat sisters. She has also developed an easy to read, locate
